#### **Day 2: Sunday, March 7, 2027**

Arrival in Buenos Aires

power. Lunch included. Overnight accommodations.




## Day 11: Tuesday, Mary 16, 2027

After exploring this extraordinary landscape, return to the Oosterdam for an unforgettable afternoon of scenic cruising through the Beagle Channel and Glacier Alley, where towering ice formations and shimmering blue glaciers create one of nature's most awe-inspiring spectacles. **Meals: Breakfast, Dinner** 

# Day 12: Wednesday, March 17, 2027

Scenic Cruising Glacier Alley

After departing Ushuaia, the Oosterdam sails through the legendary Beagle Channel, entering the stunning stretch known as Glacier Alley. Here, towering walls of ice cascade from the Darwin Range into the sea, their blue hues shifting with the light. Named after European countries—Holland, Italy, France, Germany, and Spain—each glacier is a spectacle of nature's artistry. From the deck, enjoy panoramic views of these magnificent formations and listen for the distant crackle of ice calving into the water—an unforgettable highlight of your South American journey.

# Day 13: Thursday, March 18, 2027

Scenic Cruise Sarmiento Channel


## Day 18: Tuesday, March 23, 2027
